MIDDLETOWN MAIN STREET LANE AND PARKING CLOSURES FOR ROADWAY CONSTRUCTION

On Sunday evening, May 3, 2015, from 6PM to 6AM the next morning, the west side of Main Street in Middletown (southbound travel lanes extending from the Arrogoni Bridge to Washington Street) will be milled and paved. Lane closures and significant parking restrictions are expected in this area on Sunday evening, Monday evening May 4 from 6PM to 6AM and Tuesday evening May 5 from 6PM to 6AM.

In addition to the Main Street lane and parking restrictions, travelers should be aware that some area side streets such as **Liberty Street, Ferry Street, Grand Street, and King's Avenue** may have their Main Street access temporarily restricted or closed as milling and paving operations pass those intersections. The public will be required to follow the direction of pre-positioned Middletown Police traffic officers for their own safety and the safety of the workforce attempting to complete this important overnight operation.

Furthermore, all Main Street residents and visitors are advised by the Middletown Parking Department that **parking restrictions will be in place for all three (3) evenings during construction from 6PM to 6AM**. As alternates, visitors or residents may park:

- on the East side of Main Street,
- in the City's Washington and Broad Street Lot (Kid City Lot),
- the Green St Lot
- or the City's King's Avenue lot directly behind Eli Cannon's Pub.

All parking meters, impacted by the milling and paving, on the west side of Main Street, will be covered for construction and will be a designated **NO PARKING ZONE**. Any vehicles found in this zone will be ticketed and/or towed at the owner's expense. **Meters will be restricted from 6PM to 6AM on Sunday evening May 3, Monday evening May 4 and Tuesday evening May 5.**

The City reserves the right to extend these travel and parking restricts based on varying project factors including weather. For further information please contact the Middletown Water and Sewer department at the contract number below.
