REMARKS

On 12-10-2016 at approximately 1453 hours I, Officer Thompson, was dispatched to 416 E Main St. (Stop & Shop) for a shoplifter in custody.

Upon arrival I spoke with an asset protection detective who explained that Jeanette Miranda, was caught shoplifting. Around 2:22 PM Miranda made her way to the self checkout and scanned some items but not all of them. Miranda then exited the store and was approached by the asset protection detective. Miranda was brought back inside and \$23.79 worth of merchandise was recovered that was not paid for.

Miranda was previously trespassed from Stop & Shop on 06-17-2015 (reference case #15-15065) during a shoplifting incident.

I spoke with Miranda who stated she scanned the stolen groceries which somehow did not charge within

the register. She was also not aware of the trespass and said she thought that went away when her previous court case was finalized.

On behalf of Stop & Shop, the asset protection detective wished to pursue charges against Miranda. A sworn written statement was given along with surveillance video of the incident.

Miranda was issued Misdemeanor Summons and Complaint # MC 378429 for the above charges. She was issued a court date of 12-21-2016 at GA 9 and identified by her CT drivers license.







Both individuals were issued Misdemeanor Summons for violation of Connecticut General Statute 53a-182 Disorderly Conduct and both were issued Conditions of Release.



Upon arrival I spoke to the victim, the victim stated his ex girlfriend Liza Paolini lives below him. The victim stated his apartment is the second floor apartment but he also shares the first floor apartment with Liza. She gives the victim access to do his laundry and for food. The victim stated that Liza gave him a bottle of Hydrocodone for him to take that she got from a friend that is a nurse. The victim stated he was using Liza's phone and talking to the person that gave her the bottle of Hydrocodone and that's when Liza became upset and started hitting the victim. The victim stated he went up to his apartment on the second floor to get away and Liza kicked his door in. The victim stated Liza continued to hit him and that's when he threw her phone down the stairs to get her away from him. The victim stated Liza continued break things in his apartment which included an artistic \$200 clay molded hand, a \$15 mirror, and the thermostat in his

apartment. The victim also handed me an empty bottle of Hydrocodone that he dumped out.

Liza stated the victim had asked her if she would pick up a pizza for him. Liza stated she owns the property and was letting the victim live in the second floor apartment. Liza stated she got the pizza for him and when he came down to eat it he became upset with her because she got him the wrong kind which had toppings on it that would irritate his stomach. Liza stated the victim began to yell at her and insult her by calling her fat. Liza stated the victim took the phone from her and went up to his apartment. Liza stated she went up to his apartment and kicked the door in to get her phone back and the victim threw her phone down the stairs damaging it.

Liza Paolini was issued a misdemeanor summons complaint for C.G.S. 53a-182 "disorderly conduct," and 53a-117 "criminal mischief." She has a scheduled court date of 12/12/16 at GA09 Middletown. Liza was issued a conditions of released and advised not have no contact with the victim.


