REMARKS

This is an evading motor vehicle accident that took place on Rapallo Avenue and in front of 728 Main Street. Three vehicles were involved in this motor vehicle accident including the suspects vehicle. Below is a detailed list of vehicles and operators involved:

- 1) Vehicle #1 was a 1998 Jeep, color blue driven by Alex Banning (suspect/Operator #1).**
- 2) Vehicle #2 was a 2016 Nissan, color blue bearing CT registration AD38534 and was driven by**

in (Operator #2).

3) Vehicle #3 was a 2015 Ford F350 , color blue bearing CT registration 2359DA combination driven by (Operator #3).

On Wednesday, 11/23/16 at approximately 1641 hours, I, Officer Jeffries responded to 728 Main Street for a report of an evading motor vehicle accident.

Vehicle #1 (Jeep) was traveling west on Rapallo Avenue during the initial incident.

Vehicle #3 (Ford) was parked on the west side of Rapallo Avenue during the initial incident.

Vehicle #2 (Nissan) was traveling north on Main Street during the initial incident.

Operator #3 () stated he was sitting in his vehicle when his vehicle was struck on the left side by Vehicle #1. () called 911 and provided them with the marker plate number, and direction of travel.

() stated Vehicle #1 entered Main Street traveling north bound before moving into the left lane, striking a blue Nissan, going over the curb, striking and knocking down a "no left turn sign," and proceeding in a northerly direction on Main Street in the south bound lane. () described the operator as a young white male. () stated the vehicle then traveled over the Arrigoni bridge into Portland.

Operator #2 () stated he was traveling north on Main Street when Vehicle #1 struck his left rear bumper. () stated the vehicle jumped over the curb, striking a "no left turn sign," before traveling in a northerly direction in the south bound lane on Main Street. Operator #2 had two passengers inside of the vehicle who confirmed () statement.

I observed what appeared to be new damage to Vehicle #2 and Vehicle #3 which was consistent with both operators verbal reports of how the accident occurred.

While on scene, Middletown dispatch stated Vehicle #1 was involved in a rollover motor vehicle accident in Portland. The operator of the vehicle, Alex Banning was arrested by Portland.


Upon arrival at Portland Police Department, I spoke with Alex who stated he was not driving the said vehicle at the time of the incident. Alex was altered and appeared to be under the influence of drugs and/or alcohol. I could smell a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from his breath.

Based upon my investigation, I determined that the operator (Alex) of Vehicle #1 was the contributing factor in causing both collisions. Therefore, I issued him a Misdemeanor Summons (MC397013) for the following violations of the C.G.S. 14-224(a), Evading Responsibility, 14-236, Failure to drive in proper lane, 14-237, Driving the wrong way.

Alex is scheduled to appear at Middletown Superior Court (GA-09) on 12/12/16 at 0900 hours.

REMARKS

This incident is a domestic dispute between STEVEN T. STOLFI and his girlfriend, hereinafter referred to as THE VICTIM. They have been involved in a relationship together for approximately two (2) years and reside together in Middletown, CT. They have NO children in common but have children from previous relationships.

On Saturday, 12/03/16 at 0659 hours, THE VICTIM contacted the Middletown Police Department and reported that she was threatened by MR. STOLFI in her Middletown residence.

THE VICTIM stated that on the morning of Saturday, 12/03/16 at approximately 2:30 AM, MR. STOLFI woke up and was very angry with her over take-out food they had ordered earlier. For the next 4 1/2 hours, he was antagonistic and verbally abusive towards her. THE VICTIM said that she told MR. STOLFI several times to get away from her and leave her alone. MR. STOLFI said that the only way that was going to

happen was if she called the police. THE VICTIM told MR. STOLFI several times that she didn't want to call the police. MR. STOLFI responded that he would punch her in the face and make the police come, and when he said this he was very angry and right up in her face. THE VICTIM said that she was scared and concerned for her safety and wellbeing and that MR. STOLFI continued to antagonize her until she reached a point where she did call the police. MR. STOLFI then left the area on foot.

MR. STOLFI was located in the area and was placed under arrest and transported to the Middletown Police Department. He was charged with:






REMARKS






