REMARKS

A search warrant was secured from GA-09 for the person of Nicholas McLellan, the silver 2002 Toyota Tacoma bearing CT registration 396JRH and the residence at 337 Newfield St.

On 12-5-16 at approximately 1915 HRS detectives from the Middletown Police Department with assistance from the patrol division were conducting surveillance at 337 Newfield St. OFC Wasilewski conducted a motor vehicle stop on the above listed vehicle after SGT Yepes observed it leaving the target location. McLellan and the vehicle were then taken back to 337 Newfield St where detectives served the search warrant.

In McLellan's bedroom detectives located 20 blue wax paper folds identical to the ones located in the garbage on McLellan's bed. They contained a white powder substance which we were able to identify as heroin from our training and experience. Also on the bed was one empty blue wax paper fold, a green straw which was cut in a manner consistent with a straw used to sniff narcotics, \$60.00 cash and a "AAA" card issued to Nick McLellan. There was also a pack of Marlboro cigarettes with one small black rubber band in it consistent to what was located in the garbage. In the garbage next to the bed were numerous empty wax paper folds. Under the pillow on the bed Detective Dirga located \$1210.00 in cash. On a chair next to the bed was a large metal grinder used to grind marijuana and a glass multicolored pipe with residue used to smoke marijuana. On a night stand Det Peck located a piece of mail addressed to Nicholas McLellan. On the dresser itself Det Lathrop located pay stubs for McLellan. In a pair of pants in the pocket Peck located \$5.00. A search of the closet revealed 2 jars containing marijuana residue, a black digital scale with marijuana residue and white powder residue, a partially full bottle of lactose (a common cutting agent for narcotics), a black box containing 3 cut straws, and a box of ziplock bags on the closet floor. In a pair of pants in the hamper, Det Lathrop located \$3.00 and Det Peck located \$51.00 in a pair of pants in the closet of an adjacent room's closet which contained McLellan's belongings. In McLellan's wallet, Det Lemieux located another \$50.00. The total amount of money seized was \$1379.00. In McLellan's vehicle I located a glass multi-colored pipe commonly used for smoking marijuana.

McLellan was taken into custody and transported to the Middletown Police Department for processing. He was charged with 21a-278(b) possession of narcotics with intent to sell, 21a-279(a) possession of narcotics, and 21a-267(a) possession of drug paraphernalia on UAR # 8773778 and held on a \$50,000.00 surety bond. He was given a court date of 12-6-2016 at GA-09 in Middletown.

McLellan's State Police Record Check shows an arrest in 2009 for 21a-279(c) possession of marijuana and he served 18 months probation.

At the police department, Detective Peck tested the residue on the scale and it was found positive for marijuana, cocaine and heroin. The \$1379 was seized under asset forfeiture. McLellan admitted the scale found in his closet was his, and admitted to using it to sell "weed" in the past. The street value of the heroin is \$200.00. The suspected heroin was tested using NARK kit number 3 by Det Peck revealing a yellow color indicative of the presence of heroin.

REMARKS

On 12-04-2016 at approximately 0833 hours I, Officer Thompson, was dispatched to 81 Plaza Dr. for a vandalism complaint.

Upon arrival I spoke with the maintenance man who showed me the rear lower level basement window which was broken. The screen window was also damaged and found on the ground. There was a brick laying on the ground which was possibly used to break the window. An estimated repair cost of \$100 was given for the window repair.

The apartment had been deemed unfit for occupancy by _____ of the health department. (reference case #16-29459). Placards had been placed on the doors stating the status of the apartment. The prior tenant, Calvin Whidden, had previously been residing in the apartment and was aware of the unfit for occupancy status.

Around 1500 hours I spoke with Whidden who denied breaking the window. I explained a witness observed him on the property and he later admitted to breaking the window and entering his apartment. He explained he needed to get in the apartment to get his food stamp card which was in his wallet. He said it was an emergency because he is diabetic and needed food. He said he contacted management but was advised he could not get into the unit until Monday, 12-05-2016. Whidden provided a sworn written statement of the incident and stated he made a mistake and would not return to the property.

Whidden was issued Misdemeanor Summons and Complaint #MC 378428 for 53a-117, Criminal Mischief 3rd degree and 53a-108, Criminal Trespass 2nd degree.

He was given a court date of 12-14-2016 at GA 9 and identified by prior in house photographs.

REMARKS

"Pursuant to Public Act 15-164, the Victim of this incident will be referred to as VICTIM 1 and Offender of this incident will be referred to as OFFENDER 1."

On 12/5/16 at approximately 1710 hrs, Sgt. Mazzotta, Officer DiMassa and I, Officer Tiano, responded to an undisclosed location in Middletown, CT for a report domestic. Prior to our arrival, the caller, VICTIM 1, was reporting her boyfriend, OFFENDER 1 was intoxicated and throwing items around the residence. Dispatch reported that while speaking with VICTIM 1 on the phone, yelling and screaming could be heard in the background and it was unknown at the time if this incident was physical or verbal in nature.

During interview of both parties, it was established that a altercation had taken placed between VICTIM 1 and OFFENDER 1. During the altercation, OFFENDER 1 had begun pushing VICTIM 1 and shoved her into a wall. OFFENDER 1 then threw numerous times around the residence and into the stairwell outside of

the residence. VICTIM 1 had sustained an injury during the course of this altercation which VICTIM 1 claimed was caused by OFFENDER 1 pushing and throwing items at her.

At the conclusion of this investigation, OFFENDER 1 was charged with the domestic violence offenses of C.G.S. 53a-182 Disorderly Conduct and C.G.S. 53a-61(a)(1) Assault 3rd. He was transported to Middletown Police Headquarters for booking and processing at which time he was booked, photographed and fingerprinted.

OFFENDER 1 was issued a \$20,000 surety bond and a court date of 12/6/16 at Middletown Superior Court G.A. 9. OFFENDER 1 is currently being held until his court date.
