REMARKS

On Wednesday 12/07/2016 at approximately 2040 hours, Narcotics detectives were conducting surveillance in the area of Washington St. and Pearl St. This area is known to Detectives, due to previous investigations, to have a significant amount of drug activity including sales and usage. Sgt. Yepes observed two males, one that he recognized as Trenton Bond and a second who was later identified as ARRESTED PARTY 2 (AP2). The two men were walking together, E/B on Washington St. As the parties approached the area of 150 Washington St. they stopped walking. Sgt. Yepes observed with a clear and unobstructed view as AP2 handed Bond an unknown amount of cash. Bond took the cash, turned and

walked towards the residence while AP2 stood out in front. Bond knocked on the front door of an apartment in the building, walked inside and closed the door behind himself. Several minutes later, Sgt. Yepes observed Bond exit the same door. Both he and AP2 began walking E/B on Washington St. After walking several yards, Bond handed an item to AP2 as they continued walking.

Sgt. Yepes observed the parties approaching Main St. and advised Det. Dirga, Det. Lathrop and I of his observations (consistent with hand to hand narcotics sales). Det. Lathrop and I observed the two men as they crossed Main St. and continued walking E/B on High St. Det. Dirga,

Lathrop and I made contact with AP2 and Bond as they were approaching the intersection of Melilli Plaza. We immediately identified ourselves as Police Officers and ordered them to stop walking. Both stopped walking without hesitation. Both were immediately compliant, however, as I was approaching Bond, he made a subtle movement towards the street. As Det. Lathrop approached AP2 he noticed he was clenching his left fist. As he stepped closer, Det. Lathrop observed AP2 drop a small plastic baggie containing an off-white rock-like substance which he immediately recognized as Crack Cocaine. I detained Bond and Det. Lathrop detained AP2. Narcotics Detectives are aware that individuals will regularly drop any contraband as they are being approached by Police and attempt to distance themselves from it. A search of AP2's person revealed 2 wax paper folds containing a powder substance, which Det. Lathrop recognized as suspected Heroin.

Bond was searched with negative results. However, in the area where he had moved (as I approached him) I observed 2 wax paper folds containing a powder substance, which I recognized as suspected Heroin, on the ground.

When asked where they were coming from, Bond stated he was just walking around. He was then advised that Detectives had witnessed his activity and the subsequent exchange after leaving the apartment. Bond became flustered. He then changed his story and said that he had just stopped to drop of some beers for a friend. When asked who the friend was, Bond could not come up with the individual's name.

Based on Sgt Yepes observations of the narcotics transaction, in conjunction with the evidence located, both parties were advised that they were under arrest and transported to Middletown Police Headquarters for processing.

Upon arrival, both were advised of their rights, fingerprinted and photographed.

The crack cocaine was transported to Middletown Police Headquarters where Det. Lathrop weighed it, using a department scale, for a total amount of .3 grams. Det. Lathrop then tested the Crack Cocaine which returned a positive result for the presence of cocaine using NARK Kit #13.

The 4 dosage units of Heroin were transported to Middletown Police Headquarters where Det. Lathrop tested it with NARK kit #3 which returned a positive result for the presence of Heroin.


Trenton Bond is a convicted felon, currently on probation and has previous convictions for; Possession of a Controlled Substance, Interfering/Resisting, Possession of Narcotics (multiple convictions), FTA 1 (multiple convictions), FTA 2 (multiple convictions), Possession Drugs/Para School Zone, Operating Under Suspension (multiple convictions), Assault 2, Assault 3, Probation Violation, Breach of Peace, Sale of Illegal Drugs, Sale Hallucinogen, Criminal Trespass 1, Robbery 2 (multiple convictions).

Trenton Bond was charged with violation of CGS 21a-279a1 – Possession of Narcotics, CGS 21a-278b – Sale of Narcotics, CGS 53a-167a – Interfering/Resisting. Trenton Bond was held on a \$50,000.00 Surety bond and issued a court date, at Middletown Superior Court, on 12/08/2016 at 0900 hours.
