REMARKS

"Pursuant to Public Act 15-164, the Victim of this incident will be referred to as VICTIM 1 and JUVENILE 1 and the Offender of this incident will be referred to as OFFENDER 1"

On 11/9/16 at approximately 2015 hrs, I, Officer Tiano, met with a walk in complainant in the front lobby of the Middletown Police Department regarding a domestic incident.

VICTIM 1 provided a sworn written statement where he described how he attempted to drop off their child to OFFENDER 1. It was discovered that OFFENDER 1 was intoxicated and unable to care of their child. When the child did not want to stay with OFFENDER 1, she became verbally aggressive, pushed down the window to VICTIM 1's vehicle and and climbed into the car while screaming at the child to get out of the car. While she did this, VICTIM 1 had the vehicle and drive and his foot on the brake putting all parties involved

at substantial risk of being harmed. VICTIM 1 was able to provide video evidence of this incident which substantiated his statements.

During interview of OFFENDER 1, she claimed this incident had been only verbal in nature and would only admit to reaching her arms inside of VICTIM 1's vehicle to get her child.

At the conclusion of this investigation, OFFENDER 1 was charged with the offenses of C.G.S. 53a-181 Breach of Peace and 53-21 Risk of Injury to a Minor. She was booked, photographed and finger printed on her charges. She was issued a \$1,500 non-surety bond and received a court date of 11/10/16 at G.A. 9 at 0900 hrs and was later released.
