
An itemized receipt was scanned and electronically attached to case file.

Cronk admitted that she made a stupid mistake, and didn't even know why she decided to take the items in the first place. Before leaving, I explained to her that she was not welcome in the store anymore, and if she did so, would be charged with Criminal Trespass.

Cronk was issued a misdemeanor summons (MC379991) for Larceny in the 6th Degree (C.G.S. 53a-125b) and given a court date of 11/16/16 to answer for said charges.


On 11/3/16 at approximately 1846hrs I (Officer Wasilewski) was traveling eastbound on Loveland Street when I observed a gray Honda Accord (Bearing CT Registration AB45089) improperly parked on the left side of the one-way street where signs clearly state "NO PARKING This Side of the Street Except Wednesdays 12:01AM Thru 12:00 Noon". As I drove past the vehicle I ran the vehicle registration through my cruiser computer which revealed that the registered owner (David Bouey) had a suspended license since 6/15/16. I made a U-Turn on Hubbard Street but the vehicle was gone when I pulled back onto Loveland Street. Approximately 10-15 minutes later I observed the vehicle traveling on South Main Street. I pulled behind the vehicle and followed onto the connector ramp of Route 9 where I activated my overhead emergency lights and conducted a motor vehicle stop. As the vehicle pulled to the side of the road I observed both the operator (later identified as David Bouey) and passenger (later identified as _____) moving about the front passenger area in an unnatural manner.

I exited my cruiser and approached the driver side of the vehicle. _____ was visibly nervous with wide eyes. He avoided eye contact and would not look at me when I asked him why he was moving around so much. _____ leg was on the brake pedal and visibly shaking. I explained to both that due to their unnatural movements I believed they had attempted to hide something illegal, possibly a weapon. I further explained that for my safety I was going to pat them down for weapons and search the area of the vehicle in their immediate reach such as under the seat and by the doors because I believed they had possibly hidden a weapon. _____ grew increasingly nervous. I asked him if he wanted to advise me of anything illegal on his person such as weapons or drugs prior to my patting him down. _____ then stated "I have some heroin needles on me".

Once Officer Tiano arrived on scene and conducted a search of _____ person for the needles. He subsequently found the two hypodermic needles in addition to three glassine baggies containing heroin. _____ was asked out of the vehicle and searched. No illegal substances or weapons were found on his person. The vehicle was then searched and located inside it were 6 heroin baggies, four hypodermic needles, and two empty heroin needles. After locating the heroin baggies and needles, Bouey and I were placed under arrest and transported to the Middletown Police Department by Officer Tiano and I. Bouey was read his rights, photographed, fingerprinted, and processed in the booking area. He was charged with violation of CGS 21a-267(a) Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, 21a-279(a) Possession of Narcotics, 14-215 Suspended License, and 14-251 Improper Parking. He was released on a \$10,000 non-surety bond and assigned a court date of 11/23/16 at 0900hrs. It was explained to him that he would have to appear at the GA 9 Court house on that date and time. He stated he understood.

REMARKS

On 11/10/16 at approximately 1539 hours I responded to #91 Farm Hill Road to investigate the report of a motor vehicle complaint.

Upon arrival I spoke with complainant . I was aware that () had been involved in a motor vehicle accident on 11/9/16 with the resident of #316 Farm Hill Road, Jeffrey Fazzino. At the time of that accident Fazzino had been operating his 2001 Subaru Legacy (CT registration 5568CP). The vehicle had an expired registration, Fazzino did not have valid insurance coverage, and his operator license was suspended. Fazzino had been issued a misdemeanor summons for those charges (see MPD Case #16-27680).

stated that again today at 1530 hours he saw Fazzino drive northbound by his residence operating the same vehicle. He stated Fazzino waved at him in a taunting manner. He requested Fazzino arrested for the above motor vehicle charges again.

I proceeded to #316 Farm Hill Road. Fazzino was not there nor was his vehicle. I left Fazzino a note requesting he contact me. He did and I returned to his residence at approximately 1800 hours to speak with him. At this time Fazzino's vehicle was in his driveway. During our conversation Fazzino admitted to
