REMARKS

On 11-28-2016 at approximately 1155 hours I, Officer Thompson, was dispatched to Loveland St. on the report of a physical domestic dispute.

Upon arrival I spoke outside with the female victim who stated her boyfriend, Hector Mulero slapped her in the side of her head during an argument. She displayed slight redness and a scratch mark along her left ear. She explained Mulero became upset when he thought she went in his wallet and took bus passes to Hartford that he was going to panhandle. The slap caused pain and redness along her left ear but did not require medical attention.

I located Mulero inside of the residence and he denied the claim. He confirmed they were arguing but stated the argument was verbal only and did not turn physical. He did not give any further details in regards to the altercation or the alleged claims.

Based on my investigation there was enough probable cause to pursue charges against Mulero for domestic violence. The victim's left ear was visibly red which was not consistent with her right ear. She also had a slight scratch mark along the front of the left earlobe. Pictures were taken of the injuries and the victim gave a sworn written statement of the incident.

Mulero was placed under arrest and transported to headquarters for processing. He was charged with violation of CGS 53a-61, Assault 3rd degree and 53a-182, Disorderly Conduct. He was released on a \$5000 non surety bond and issued a family violence conditions of release with a no contact order. He was given a court date of 11-29-2016 at GA 9.

Pursuant to Connecticut General Statute 54-86e, the victim in this incident, a 57 year old female, will be referred to as Victim1.

On 11/28/16 at approximately 1803 hours Officer Wasilewski and I responded to Middletown Police Headquarters for a walk in larceny complaint.

Upon arrival I spoke with Witness1. She gave a sworn written statement stating she observed Larry Wiggins at Victim1's residence at approximately 12:30pm on 11/28/16 and there is a protective order in place, where Wiggins must stay away from Victim1's home.

Officer Wasilewski and I determined there is in fact an active protective order in which Larry Wiggins must stay away from the home of Victim1.

Officer Wasilewski and I spoke with Witness2. Witness2 provided a sworn written statement stating at about 12:30pm on 11/28/16, she saw Larry Wiggins car in the driveway of Victim1's house. At about 2:00pm I saw Larry Wiggins driving his vehicle away from Victim1's house.

Officer Wasilewski and I made contact with Larry Wiggins. Larry Wiggins admitted to being at Victim1's residence at 12:30pm.

Larry Wiggins was charged with 53a-223 Criminal violation of a protective order on UAR # 8873752. He was issued a court date of 11/29/16 at GA09 in Middletown and held on a \$50,000 surety bond.

Upon police arrival it was determined that O1 had been arrested on Domestic Charges earlier in the day and that this incident violated the conditions of release. O1 told V1 that "he should have kicked her ass for calling police" referring to the call placed earlier in the day and that when V1 attempted to call police again, O1 grabbed the phone preventing the call. The argument continued outside of the residence at which point it was called in by neighbors.


As police arrived on scene, O1 fled on Oak ST. Police utilized a K9 for a track. Upon first contact with O1, O1 ran, engaging police in a foot pursuit. O1 was apprehended.


O1 was processed in accordance with Middletown Police Standard Operating Procedure. O1 was charged with being in violation of C.G.S. 53a-167a Interfering Resisting Arrest, 53a-181 Breach of Peace 2nd, 53a-183b Interfering with Emer. 911 Call, 53a-62 Threatening 2nd, 53a-222a Violation of Conditions of release.

During booking O1 claimed a hip injury sustained while running from police and jumping a fence. Hunters Paramedics were called to the booking area for an evaluation. Preliminary evaluation showed need for further medical treatment. O1 was transported to Middlesex Hospital for further treatment.

Upon release from the Hospital, O1 will be held on a \$50,000.00 Cash/Surety bond for this case and a \$55,000.00 Total.

REMARKS

On 11/19/16 at approximately 1347 hours I, Officer Murphy responded to the area of 557 Newfield St for a motor vehicle accident with no injuries. Dispatch added that it was reported that an older model Nissan Pathfinder bearing CTReg#7ANUU2 had evaded the scene.

With the assistance of witnesses on scene we were able to locate the evading vehicle described above parked on Pomeroy Place. I subsequently made contact with the registered owner, Richard Cox who admitted to driving away from the accident because he "was scared". Cox's vehicle also had front end damage consistent with the accident I was investigating. Cox was additionally only able to provide a valid CT ID card as identification and stated that he did not have a license.

Cox was subsequently issued Misdemeanor Summons #MC378275 for violating C.G.S. 14-224(b)** (Evading Responsibility) and C.G.S. 14-36(a) (Operating Motor Vehicle Without License). He was released

on a Promise To Appear and is scheduled to appear in court on 11/29/16 at 0900 hours.
