

**REMARKS**

**(ASSET FORFEITURE)**

On 10/2/16 at approximately 1711hrs several Officers as well as myself (Officer Wasilewski) were dispatch to the area of Glover Place and Pearl Street for a report of 6-8 people fighting in the street. As Officer Remotti and I were approaching the intersection of Glover and Pearl Street, Sergeant Baboolal radioed that the white Malibu with CT registration AB42953 was leaving the scene at a high rate of speed.


Officer Remotti and I immediately observed the white Malibu speeding through the intersection past Sergeant Baboolal heading westbound onto Lincoln Street. Officer Remotti and I (Officer Wasilewski) conducted a motor vehicle stop and ordered the operator, later identified as Tysnick Hoggard, to show his hands. Hoggard was taken out of the vehicle and searched due to the strong odor of marijuana coming from the vehicle as well as on his person. Hoggard was found to be in possession of two bags of Marijuana. One smaller bag was the size of a quarter and weighed 1.11 grams. The second was the size of a baseball and weighed 8.12 grams.


Also in Hoggard's possession was a large sum on US currency broken into individual folds containing different denominations, indicative of street level narcotic sales. The money was later counted by myself (Officer Wasilewski) and Officer Remotti. The money totaled \$669.00 which was tagged as Asset Forfeiture and sealed in a clear Currency Pouch with each denomination quantity listed. Hoggard was also in possession of two cell phones which continually rang as I searched the vehicle. Both cell phones were also seized as asset forfeiture. One phone was a blue color AT&T phone. The second was a T-Mobile I-Phone 6 Plus with a blue case.

While I was continuing a search of the vehicle, Sergeant Baboolal arrived on scene of the motor vehicle stop and opened the door to speak with Hoggard. He then noticed that Hoggard appeared to have something in his mouth. Sergeant Baboolal and Officer Remotti ordered Hoggard to spit out whatever he had in his mouth. Eventually Hoggard spit out a bundle (10 bags of heroin) of glassine baggies of heroin.

Through my training and experience as a Police Officer, I was able to identify Hoggard's large sum of money (\$669), baggies of individually wrapped heroin, and two constantly ringing cell phones as being indicative of street level narcotic sales

Hoggard was placed under arrest and transported to the Middletown Police Department where he was read his rights, photographed, fingerprinted, and processed by Officer Remotti. Hoggard was charged with violation of CGS 21a-279 Possession of Narcotics, 21a-278(a) Possession of Narcotics with Intent to Sell, 21a-279a(a)(1) Possession of Less than 1/2 Ounce Marijuana, 53a-167a Interfering with an Officer, and 53a-155 Tampering/Destruction of Evidence. Hoggard posted bond and was released on a \$20,000 Surety Bond. Hoggard was assigned a court date of 10/17/16 at 0900hrs and told he would have to appear at the GA 9 court house on that date and time. Nothing further.

vehicle (Jeep) parked on Main Street near Los Promos Market.

The vehicle was later stopped by patrol officers and narcotics detectives. The operator of the vehicle was identified as Shelby Ward. Ward's operator's license was suspended and the vehicle was confirmed by MPD dispatch as a stolen vehicle.

A search of the vehicle revealed a small amount of crack cocaine on the driver side floor. Ward was placed under arrest and the vehicle was secured and towed from the scene. The crack cocaine was field tested by Sgt. Yepes using NARK Kit #4, which produced a positive reaction for the presumptive presence of cocaine. Two more small pieces were located and transported to MPD headquarters. Detective Peck used a NIK wipe to test the two other small pieces of suspected crack cocaine which yielded positive results.

Ward claimed to have the title of the vehicle signed by the vehicle owner. A copy of the title was located and a signature was on the back of the title but it did not match the signature of the vehicle owner. The vehicle owner's signature was obtained by Narcotics Detectives on a sworn statement from the vehicle owner.

Once back at MPD headquarters Detective Dirga advised Ward of her Miranda Rights in writing which she acknowledged and signed off on at 2254 hours. Ward was then, fingerprinted, processed and photographed under UAR# 8873596 in violation of C.G.S.53a-124 Larceny in the Third Degree and 53a-139 Forgery in the Second Degree.

Ward was held on a combined \$100,000 surety bond and issued a court date of 10-11-2016 at GA-09.

A records check of Ward revealed 4 prior arrests with convictions of Forgery 2nd, Possession of Narcotics, Breach of Peace 2nd, Criminal Mischief, and Threatening.

**REMARKS**

On 10/9/2016 at 0000hrs, I Ofc. Sanford, responded to ADDRESS for a reported domestic dispute. Anonymous neighbors had reported they heard yelling and banging coming from the apartment. Upon arrival I met with VICTIM 1 who appeared shaken up and stated they had been in an argument and that they were the only two parties in the apartment.

I began speaking with Pete Medina, who was uncooperative and was unwilling to give his side of the incident. Medina refused to answer any questions and told me to ask VICTIM 1.

VICTIM 1 provided a sworn written statement that reads:

"On Oct 8, 2016 at approx 7PM I, VICTIM 1, was at my residence of ADDRESS with my boyfriend Pete Medina. We began arguing and Pete became vulgar calling me expletives. I called my mother in Oklahoma and told her I wanted him to leave. Pete became angry and initially hit me with a pillow. I pushed the pillow away at which point Pete began to grab me around the throat and shoved me to the floor. When he shoved me to the ground I hit my ankle on the bed frame causing a laceration on my left ankle. I tried to run out of my apartment to call 911 and I ran into my neighbor who had come down to check on the commotion. At that point Pete came and got loud with my neighbor and said "Don't you ever fucking help her, I'll hit you too". When we got back to the apartment Pete became even more irate and hit me again with pillow. He stated "If you want me to be abusive...I'll show you abusive." I did not have my phone to call 911 because Pete threw it. At that point the police showed up.

VICTIM 1 had scratches on her arms and face and a laceration covered by bandaids on her ankle. Neighbors who were outside at the time stated they have heard on multiple occasions yelling and banging coming from the apartment and stated they had been concerned for VICTIM 1 in the past.

Medina was transported to Middletown Police Headquarters where he was charged with 53a-61 - Assault 3rd, 53a-182 - Disorderly Conduct, and 53a-183b - Interfering with a 911 call. Medina was held on a \$50,000 surety bond with a court date of 10/11/2016.



REMARKS

On 10/9/2016 at 2011hrs, I Ofc. Sanford, responded to 866 East Street to assist a party with advice regarding their sister and her care of her nephew. I spoke with [redacted] and [redacted] who stated they were concerned about Shelley Corcoran. [redacted] stated Shelley had left her 5 year old son with VICTIM1. [redacted] stated she was contacted by VICTIM1 through Facebook stating that Shelley said she was going to the store for a few minutes and after not returning for several hours, VICTIM1 reached out to [redacted]. VICTIM1 has an active no contact protective order against Corcoran.

[redacted] and [redacted] went to their residence at 1379 Newfield Street where they found JUVENILE in the care of VICTIM1. I [redacted] other sister, [redacted] arrived at Newfield Street as well at which point VICTIM1 left. While at the residence, Shelley returned home and when she discovered VICTIM1 had left, she went to go find him at his residence at ADDRESS. VICTIM1's mother told Shelley to leave, at which point she did. JUVENILE was taken by [redacted] to her residence where she stated she would care for the child until other arrangements could be made.

I spoke with VICTIM1 who stated Shelley had reached out to him early in the morning asking to get together. VICTIM1 provided a sworn written statement that reads:

"On 10/9/2016 during the early morning hours, my mother received a phone call form Shelley Corcoran. I knew Shelley was calling me so I answered. Shelley asked me to go to Walmart before we would go to a birthday party. Shelly picked me up and we went to Walmart. Afterwards we went to her house and fell asleep. We continued sleeping and woke up around 11am. Myself, Shelley, and her son JUVENILE hung out until she said she had to leave around 12:30. Shelley did not return for several hours. I contacted her family who came to care for JUVENILE. I got a ride home, and about 15 minutes later Shelley came to my house and my mom told her to leave. Shelley then called me leaving a voicemail and sent my mom another text. Shelley has a protective order with me from a previous incident."

VICTIM1 showed me the text messages in the phone from earlier in the day which I asked him to screen shot to include with the report.


I located Shelley Corcoran at her 1379 Newfield Street where she was placed under arrest. I transported Corcoran to Middletown Police Headquarters where she was processed for the charge of 53a-223\* - Criminal Violation of a Protective Order.

Shelley admitted to contacting VICTIM1 and to spending time with him on 10/8/2016 and 10/9/2016. Shelley stated she had lost track of time while out shopping and her phone was dead, making her unreachable.


Corcoran was held on a \$10,00 surety bond with a court date of 10/11/2016.

### REMARKS

On 10/10/16 at approximately 12:46 hours, Ofc. Aura Smith and Ofc. Liistro were dispatched to a domestic at Spear park on William Street involving Tyrone Taylor.

I, Ofc. Passacantando was traveling north on Main Street by Green Street and saw Tyrone Taylor on the corner with a female who was flagging me down. I spoke to the female who was later identified as the victim and she stated Taylor punched her. During this time I attempted to notify dispatch that I was out with the involved parties. While doing this Taylor walked up to me and stated, "Don't you fucking think about calling more people here." Taylor then started to yell at the victim. He was disobeying any of my commands and refused to calm down. In an attempt to control the situation I told Taylor I would be detaining him in handcuffs. When trying to place his hands behind his back Taylor pulled away and turned around in a fighting stance and clenched his fists. I was able to pull Taylor to the ground but was unable to place him in handcuffs. Taylor continued to disobey any of my commands. He was able to get back on his feet and he attempted to punch me multiple times with his right and left hands but missed. I kicked Taylor in the stomach and punched him on the left side of his head and placed him in a head lock. While attempting to pull him down to the ground I tripped over curbing and fell to the ground with Taylor on top of me. Taylor began trying to punch me since I had fallen to the ground. Taylor struck me on the right side of my face. At this time Det. Woolard, Capt. Lozefski arrived on scene and Taylor was placed in handcuffs.

While transporting Taylor to police headquarters he started threatening me by shouting, "Your a Bitch Ass Nigga, you ain't shit in that uniform, I'm gonna get your ass you wait!"

After arriving at Headquarters Taylor continued to be uncooperative and refused to let officers process him or fingerprint him. Taylor intentionally urinated on the floor in the holding cage.


During the incident I suffered minor pain to the right side of my face, minor abrasions to fingers on my left hand, and lower back pain from when I fell to the ground.

Taylor is being charged with C.G.S. 53a-167c "assault on an officer," 53a-167a "interfering with an officer," 53a-182 "disorderly conduct," 29-17 "refused to be fingerprinted." Taylor is held on a \$25,000 bond with a scheduled court date of 10/11/16 at GA09 Middletown.



walked over to his porch and called the police while Offender #1 walked away. Officers verified there were no active orders of protection between Victim #1 and Offender #1.



On Monday 10-10-2016 at approximately 2130 hours I (Detective Lathrop) and Detective Peck located the above

vehicle (Jeep) parked on Main Street near Los Promos Market.

The vehicle was later stopped by patrol officers and narcotics detectives. The operator of the vehicle was identified as Shelby Ward. Ward's operator's license was suspended and the vehicle was confirmed by MPD dispatch as a stolen vehicle.

A search of the vehicle revealed a small amount of crack cocaine on the driver side floor. Ward was placed under arrest and the vehicle was secured and towed from the scene. The crack cocaine was field tested by Sgt. Yepes using NARK Kit #4, which produced a positive reaction for the presumptive presence of cocaine. Two more small pieces were located and transported to MPD headquarters. Detective Peck used a NIK wipe to test the two other small pieces of suspected crack cocaine which yielded positive results.

Ward claimed to have the title of the vehicle signed by the vehicle owner. A copy of the title was located and a signature was on the back of the title but it did not match the signature of the vehicle owner. The vehicle owner's signature was obtained by Narcotics Detectives on a sworn statement from the vehicle owner.

Ward was also fingerprinted, processed and photographed under UAR# 8873594 in violation of C.G.S.21a-279(a)(1) Possession of a controlled substance and UAR # 8873595 in violation of C.G.S 14-215 operation under suspension.

Ward was held on a combined \$25,000 surety bond and issued a court date of 10-11-2016 at GA-09.


