Lunches and Snacks:

Lunch and snack will be provided daily for campers, through CRT. We encourage campers to bring a water bottle daily. They may carry them around all day to keep themselves hydrated. Menus available on the web site listed above.

Field Trips and Swimming:

*Your child will need a **RED** T-shirt that must be worn on field trips.

Red t-Shirts must be worn on field trips so that our campers are easily identifiable in crowded off-site areas. We travel off site twice a week, once for a field trip and once for swimming at Veteran's Memorial Pool.

Every Tuesday we will spend the afternoon at Vet's Pool. Campers should bring their swim suits on this day. Please be sure campers bring a towel and sunscreen. Campers are not allowed to wear goggles during their swim at Vet's Pool. All campers are swim tested and each group is monitored by lifeguards and camp staff at all times.

Please bring a labeled bottle of sunscreen every day!

Personal Items:

No electronics, games, cards or money should be brought to camp. We are not responsible for any lost or stolen items.

Parent transportation:

Please do not drop off participants at camp before 8:55 am and please pick them by 3:00PM sharp. If anyone else is picking up your child that is not on the registration form we must have a signed note indicating who is picking up your child. There is a sign-out sheet for all parent pick-ups that needs to be signed when taking your child home from camp.

Clothing:

During the day, your child will be participating in many fun group activities both inside and outside. Comfortable, play clothes are recommended and as a safety precaution **sneakers must be worn** every day.

Rules:

Inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated.

Respect yourself, other campers and all staff!

Keep your hands, feet, objects and belongings to yourselves.

No swearing, put-downs or bullying.

Consequences:

Verbal warning and/or a phone call home.

If a child misbehaves or endangers himself/herself or others he/she will receive a disciplinary action form that will be sent home for a parent's signature. The child will also be suspended from camp for one day. A signed copy of the disciplinary action form must be returned to camp in order for your child to return to camp. If a child receives three write-ups they will be suspended from camp for the duration of the summer. If any participant displays unsafe behavior at camp, they may be suspended from off-site activities. A child may be suspended immediately for a serious behavior incident without a refund.

Participant Behavior Rules

Please review the "Participant's Behavior Rules" with your child so they are familiar with the program's expectations prior to arrival. Please be advised that if your child does not comply with these rules, he/she may be asked to leave and no refunds will be provided.

In order to ensure the safety of our participants and to provide the most rewarding and enjoyable recreation experience we can, we must insist on a standard of behavior that includes the following:

- ⇒ Children must respect staff, other participants and equipment, at all times.
- ⇒ Children must practice fair play, honesty, and good sportsmanship.
- ⇒ Children must be able to cooperate in a large group setting.
- ⇒ Children must follow instructions and rules.
- ⇒ Children must be aware of obvious dangers (roads, water, etc.).
- ⇒ Children must be able to interact positively with fellow participants and staff.
- ⇒ Children must be able to use the bathroom independently.
- ⇒ Children must stay with their group and listen to the staff members.

The following will not be allowed and will be grounds for dismissal:

- Inappropriate, disrespectful, uncooperative or disruptive behavior
- Abusive language and inappropriate gestures
- Injuring another participant, staff or person through an inappropriate action
- Fighting or putting your hands on any other person in a harmful or inappropriate way
- Throwing things in anger
- Biting, spitting on others, equipment or property
- Stealing or misuse of property
- Bringing cigarettes, alcohol, drugs, firearms, knives or weapons of any sort on the bus or to camp
- Any other behavior that the City of Middletown deems disruptive to its program or compromises the safety of others

We understand that Parents/Guardians and participant (s) will be held responsible for participant (s) actions at rec programs. We understand that part of the recreation experience involves activities and interactions that may be new to my child, and that they come with certain risks. I have instructed my child on the importance of abiding by the rules. My child and I both agree that he or she is familiar with these rules and will obey them. Failure to adhere to these rules may result in immediate dismissal from a recreation program with no refund. **By signing the registration forms on page 10 and/or 37 you acknowledge these rules.**

With your help, The Memorial will stand as a testament to them for all they have given.


