Press Release

As a result of the building collapse on Main Street, the following road closures and traffic patterns will be in place starting on February 03, 2011 at approximately 0500 hours:

Main Street will remain closed between Washington Street (Route 66) and Grand Street.

All southbound traffic on Main Street from the area of Saint Johns Square will be detoured by traffic cones onto Rapallo Avenue or Grand Street. All northbound traffic on Rapallo Avenue will be detoured by traffic cones northbound onto Main Street. (The traffic signal at the intersection of Main Street and Grand Street will be turned off, and traffic will flow freely within their respective cone patterns).

Grand Street will be closed to eastbound traffic between High Street and Main Street. Detour signs will be in place to assist motorists.

Middletown Police Officers will be assigned to various intersections to assist motorists.

The Traffic Unit will set up the various cone patterns/barricades, and will adjust the traffic pattern/traffic signals accordingly.
