Middletown Update on Winter Storm Alfred

Middletown — Mayor Sebastian Giuliano would like to remind Middletown residents that the emergency shelter at Middletown High, 200 LaRosa Ln is open. Showers, food, in the form of meals ready to eat - MRE's, and charging of devices is available. Pets will be allowed and should be in carriers. Pet owners must provide food and any necessary medications for their pets.

Approximately 93% of Middletown residents are without power.

Today CL&P crews, along with City Public Works crews, will be removing trees and debris from roads and wires. With the restoration of power to begin when that is accomplished. The Governor and CL&P issued a statement that this process could take up to a week to restore power.

You are also advised to be careful around any downed trees or branches, as wires could possibly be intertwined and not visible.
