- Special Meeting** A community meeting of the Common Council of the City of Middletown was held in the Council Chamber of the municipal building on Thursday, January 13, 2011 at 7 p.m.

- Meeting Called to Order** The Mayor called the meeting to order at 7:04 p.m. and leads the public in the Pledge of Allegiance.
- Call of Meeting Read** The Call of Meeting was read and accepted. Mayor Giuliano declares the Call a Legal Call and the Meeting a Legal Meeting.
- Public Comment Opens** The Chair opens public comment on items under the jurisdiction of the Common Council at 7:04 p.m. He asks if there are any members of the public wishing to speak.
